



# MERLYNSTON CREEK PARK, STAGE 4 DRAFT CONCEPT PLAN 2019

This upgrade proposes to transform this existing bare grassed area in North Coburg, into a welcoming, treed landscape with many opportunities for active, passive and imaginative play for all ages with a blend of indigenous and exotic plant species.

This design has been informed by many ideas and suggestions already put forward by the local community and students from Pascoe Vale North Primary School, and proposes to utilise many recycled and local materials to create a unique park space for all to use.

Patrons will be able to stop for a picnic, play on the proposed contemporary equipment and natural play elements or open grassed areas. A small orchard with fruiting and other edible trees for locals to pick seasonally will be planted.

These new landscape features will activate the space and provide better access through this reserve and a destination for locals to enjoy.
