DESIGN STATEMENT

Pipe anchor block is a drainage system component for stopping underground drainage pipe slipping down on steep slopes.

APPLICABLE LOCATION

Pipe anchor blocks should be installed for drainage pipes where grade of pipe exceeds 1 in 7 and distance between pits exceeds 9 metres. Spacing of anchor block to be 9 metres maximum or as specified.

- 1. Pipe anchor blocks shall be used where the pipe slope exceeds 1 in 7 and the distance between pits exceeds 9 metres.
- 2. Concrete for anchor blocks shall be of strength 20 MPa at 28 days.
- 3. Pipe anchor blocks shall be spaced at 9m apart unless specified otherwise.





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
