MIXED RECYCLING BIN



- Put your recycling in the bin loose, not in bags.
- Items must be empty.
- Flatten cardboard boxes to save space.
- Take eligible drink cans and bottles to a Container Deposit Scheme drop-off point for a 10 cent refund. Find your nearest refund point here: cdsvic.gov.au/locations


GLASS RECYCLING BIN



- For glass bottles and jars only.
- Put your glass bottles and jars in the bin loose, not in bags.
- Put all other glass in your general rubbish bin.
- Glass bottles and jars must be empty.
- Jar lids and bottle caps should be firmly attached.
- Put loose lids and bottle caps in the general rubbish bin.

FOOD AND GARDEN ORGANICS BIN

GENERAL RUBBISH BIN





- Food scraps and garden clippings only.
- Put in your bin loose or use paper towels to wrap food waste.
- All packaging must be removed, including fruit stickers.
- Compostable bags are not accepted.

- Use this bin only for items that can't be reused or recycled.
