Brunswick's creative studios are opening their doors to the public.

The Brunswick Design District is inviting locals to step inside 13 working studios across the neighbourhood for a rare behind-the-scenes experience.

Designers, makers and creative studios will open their doors, sharing what they do and how they do it.

Supported by Merri-bek City Council, Creative Victoria and RMIT University, the initiative highlights Brunswick's growing reputation as one of Melbourne's most vibrant creative hubs.

Brunswick has long been home to independent designers, artists and craftspeople working quietly behind roller doors and inside converted warehouses. The Brunswick Design District brings more of that energy out into the open – celebrating our rich creative community.

You can experience a range of studios showcasing many kinds of design including furniture, millinery, textiles, art, lighting and medical design.

Ed Linacre from Mycelium Studios in Brunswick East is opening up for a special Melbourne Design Week exhibition called Fruiting Bodies, created by a group of local creatives.

'We're looking forward to opening the doors of Mycelium Studios,' Ed says, 'and sharing the amazing work that happens as a creative space in the Brunswick Design District.'

Whether you're curious about how things are made, interested in design, or simply keen to explore your neighbourhood in a new way, The Brunswick Design District Open Studios is an invitation: come inside, meet your neighbours, and discover the ideas shaping this special part of Melbourne.

York Street Park is now complete

Your new Park Close to Home at 33 Westgate Street, in Pascoe Vale South, is now ready for our community to enjoy.

Residents and visitors to the area can now use the park and enjoy the blend of tranquil spaces created through a mix of indigenous and exotic planting that brings light and shade to cool the area. For our visitors who are young and young-at-heart, there are adventure areas to enjoy through the story of the blue tongue lizard's life cycle.

The landscape architect has thoughtfully woven the story of the blue tongue lizard into the design through sculpture and artwork, paving, seating, play, and planting.

The park is Merri-bek City Council's newest 'Park Close to Home'. This is a Council initiative which aims to improve access to open space in areas of Merri-bek with no parks in walking distance.

Let's talk fortnightly rubbish

In June, Council will make a final decision about a proposed change to kerbside rubbish bins. From July 2027, we are planning to change rubbish bin collections from weekly to fortnightly and provide households with a larger rubbish bin. Your weekly Food and Garden Organics (FOGO) collection will stay the same, along with fortnightly recycling and monthly glass collections. If the change is approved, the standard rubbish bin will increase from 80 to 120 litres. If eligible, households may be able to get a bigger bin at no extra cost.

Why this change?

This change helps reduce the amount of waste sent to landfill while keeping costs down for ratepayers. Twenty-six Victorian councils have already introduced rubbish collection every 2 weeks.

Helping manage costs

Reducing landfill waste helps lower costs. Sending waste to landfill is more expensive than composting or recycling materials. Reducing landfill volumes and collecting rubbish bins every 2 weeks helps lower disposal and collection costs, which are paid for through the waste charge.

Making better use of your bins

Food waste placed in general rubbish bins goes to landfill, where it produces greenhouse gases as it breaks down and contributes to climate change.

In Merri-bek, food waste currently makes up about one-third of the average rubbish bin by weight. By placing food scraps in weekly FOGO bins instead, more waste can be composted and less ends up in landfill.

A trial of fortnightly rubbish collections started in parts of Hadfield, Brunswick and Brunswick West resulting in many households now placing more food waste into their weekly FOGO bins.

Results from the trial

More food waste is going into FOGO bins which means less waste is being sent to landfill.

By participants putting food waste in their FOGO bin, general rubbish has decreased by 19% – that's a reduction of 3kg per household every fortnight.



Looking for a welcoming place to host a workshop, meeting or celebration? We have a range of affordable venues available for hire, from spacious halls to smaller meeting rooms.

Whether you are running a community class, planning a business meeting, hosting a birthday or organising a local club gathering, there are flexible spaces available across Merri-bek.

Many venues have comfortable meeting rooms for workshops and group discussions.

Tables, chairs, presentation equipment and accessible facilities are available, making the spaces suitable for training sessions, community classes and meetings.

Rooms can often be booked during the day, evenings or weekends, giving organisers flexibility when planning events.

For larger gatherings, community halls provide versatile spaces for celebrations, performances, fitness classes and cultural events. Open floor areas and kitchen facilities at many locations make it easy to adapt the space for different occasions.

Council facilities are located throughout Merri-bek, making it easy to find a space close to home.

Hire fees vary depending on the location and event type, with reduced rates available for community and not-for-profit groups.

Designed for children aged 3 and 4, the program is led by a qualified early childhood teacher who supports each child's development in a warm and nurturing environment.

Through fun, hands-on activities, children build confidence, independence, and important social and emotional skills that help set them up for life.

You can apply for this now if your child turns 3 or 4 before 30 April 2027.

Your library, at home

We deliver library books, and other library items, to people living in Merri-bek who find it tricky visiting the library – or carrying books home – due to disability, ill-health or older age.

Deliveries are made to your home every 4 weeks. Our Home Library Service staff can select items for you, or you can choose from a wide range of fiction, non-fiction, large print books, audiobooks and magazines. There are also items available in some community languages too.

Brunswick resident Natalie uses the Home Library Service to borrow a broad mix of titles. She says she knew the service supported older people but didn't realise it was also available to younger people with disability.

"I've always loved libraries in general but now I am quite evangelical about the Home Library Service too. I just want to tell everyone!"

Natalie has enjoyed everything from Jane Austen to political non-fiction and the latest folk-horror novellas through the free, to-your-door service.

"There's just such a huge range of amazing material. It can be hard to even believe it."

"Signing up to the Home Library Service is so much easier than you think it will be, and so much more useful."

Good design for growing neighbourhoods

Merri-bek is growing, and Council is working to ensure new homes are well designed, sustainable and suited to our neighbourhoods.

To support this, we've developed the Townhouse Exemplar Designs guide, featuring 8 high-quality townhouse designs created by a leading Melbourne architectural practice with funding from the Australian Government Housing Support Program.

The designs show how townhouses can be simple, well planned and sustainable. They highlight strong connections to outdoor areas, efficient use of space and thoughtful layouts that support comfortable living. The homes are also designed to appeal to a wide range of people.

The guide can be used early in a project to help developers, builders and landowners explore what's possible on their site and support smoother planning.

Age well in Merri-bek: free support that makes a difference

If you'd like guidance about aged care services or want to explore new ways to stay involved in your community, our Age Well Program is available.

Merri-bek's Age Well Program offers free, personalised and confidential support to help older residents – and their families and carers – make informed decisions and feel confident about what's available.

We spoke with Giovanna, an older resident from Pascoe Vale, happy with the Age Well Program. She is now connected to a physio class she loves for both the therapy and the social connection. Giovanna says:

“Before I met with Council's Age Well Planner Elaine, I was worried I'd be waiting for a very long time to connect with services.”

“The service is great and I recommend others reach out too. It's been a big relief to have someone guide me.”

Our Age Well Planners can support you to:

- Navigate My Aged Care and understand how aged care supports work.
- Explore programs and supports that suit your goals and lifestyle.
- Advocate for the services you need and review your care options.
- Find social activities, exercise programs and volunteering opportunities.
- Plan ahead with confidence for the future.

“I feel much more confident now and know I have someone to turn to when I need advice,” Giovanna shared.

The program is free for all Merri-bek residents aged 65+, or 50+ for Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander communities. No referral is needed.

We can help you over the phone or meet with you at home or at our offices in Glenroy, Coburg, or Brunswick.
