

How to make

Seed Bombs



Supplies needed:

- Newspaper/scrap paper of any colour
- Water
- Blender
- Seeds (flowers or herb seeds work well)
- Bowl
- Cloth/rag
- Dish cloth/papertowel



There are many different techniques for making seed bombs. This recipe uses recycled paper, but you can use clay soil and compost instead.

Instructions

Rip up scrap paper/newspaper into tiny pieces





- 2. Put paper into blender
- 3. Pour water in, so that it is just covered
- 4. Blend into a pulp

- 5. When pulp is formed, remove from blender and place into cloth/rag
- 6. Squeeze water out of pulp



7. Place pulp in mixing bowl and pour in seeds to combine together

8. Roll mixture into balls or place in cookie cutters or silicon shape trays.





9. Soak up any extra moisture with dry dish cloth/paper towel

- 10. Leave to dry for 24 hours
- 11. Your seed bombs are ready to store, give as a gift or throw at the garden and wait for rain!
